

Minutes of the Pre - bid Meeting held on 30.01.2012 in connection with tender for Procurement of Short Range Navigational Radar

A Pre - bid meeting was held at 3 pm on 30.01.2012 at IWAI, HO, Noida in connection with tender for Procurement of Short Range Navigational Radar, list of participants is annexed.

Sl. No	Points raised by participants	Clarification/decision of IWAI
1	In page 24 clause 14(a), (i) the last sentence in 1 st Para (The payment will be released by IWAI, Noida after deducting balance SD within next 15 days).	This sentence stands deleted.
2	In page 24 clause 14(a)(i) the 2 nd last sentence in 1 st para The Officer in-charge of the Authority at field office or their representative, having received the items in good condition, would certify the bills within 15 days of supply.	The sentence to be read as "The Officer in-charge of the Authority at field office or their representative, having received the items in good condition (supply of equipment in good physical condition without any transit damage), would certify the bills within 15 days of supply".
3	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)	EMD in the form of DD for Rs. 1.5 lakhs should be submitted along with the BID. BG will not be accepted.
4	Security Deposit (SD)	Successful tenderer has to remit 5% of the contract value in the form of Demand Draft as SD after adjusting the EMD of Rs. 1.5 lakhs.
5	Way Bill – IWAI has to arrange way bill for supply of equipment for IWAI Guwahati and Kolkata Offices as way bill is applicable in the states of Assam and West Bengal.	The supplier has to prepare all the necessary documents and the concerned field offices of IWAI (Kolkata and Guwahati) will sign and submit the documents for obtaining necessary way bill from the concerned state department. However the representative of the supplier has to do all follow up action with the state department for obtaining the way bill.
6	Delivery Period – The supplier has to get DGFT licence prior to import of equipment which require minimum 2 months time. Hence the delivery period may extend to 90 days.	The supplier has to deliver the equipment within 90 days (Ninety days) from the date of issue of work order. However, no change is agreed for installation and commissioning of equipment i.e. the supplier has to install and commission the equipment within 60 days (Sixty days) from the date of delivery of equipment.
7	Horizontal Beam Width – Instead of minimum 6 ^o it should be minimum 1 ^o	Minimum1 ^o horizontal beam width may provide less coverage and therefore not suitable for the purpose of IWAI as the vessel is to be operated in Inland Waters where width of the channel may sometimes be less than 50 m. Hence there will not be any change in this regard.

8	Equipment shall be as per DG/SOLAS approved of specifications	DG/SOLAS approved equipment is mandatory for sea going vessels. Since the equipment is meant for use in survey vessels operating in Inland Waters, no such mandatory approval is required.
9	Technical specifications	The technical specification given in page 41 of the tender document is the minimum requirement for the equipment. Supplier may supply equipment of the same or better specifications.
10	Extension of time for submission of bid – May be extended for at least one week.	The last date of submission of bid has been extended up to 3 pm on 13.02.2012.
